Look at Dadiji's face and image...

Om Shanti, Om Shanti, Om Shanti...

Today we are remembering Dadiji. She is mine and she is yours. She is the Jewel of Light. You could see light emanating from that jewel. See her face. See her image. She is wonderful. Don't look at me! Look at her picture closely (it was on the right side of the stage in the Auditorium). I am 103 years old. (Sudesh Bhen said, "Dadi, in fact you are 13 years old. The 0 in the centre stands for Baba). She was the first surrendered kumari at only 15 years of age. In Karachi, she surrendered her life to Baba. Brahma Baba used to call her 'Kumarka'. We called her 'Kumarka but officially her name was 'Prakashmani'.

Dadi Prakashmani saw that I was bringing foreigners to Madhuban and so she did not allow me to stay in there. She would tell me that it was better for me to go back overseas and create Baba's children abroad. She never let me sit in Madhuban. She would ask me why I was sitting in Madhuban. She would inspire me to go to the foreign lands to serve. She especially wanted me to be in London. She felt that was important. She said I was the son who had to earn an income for Baba through service. We didn't have big halls in London at that time. Now, all of you can sit here. Dadiji did the inauguration of Global Co-operation House in 1991. I remember her sitting on this stage and being crowned with a beautiful tiara.

She was the embodiment of love. She liked being close to everyone. She always kept everyone in front; this was her speciality – her wonder...
