

Sometimes people ask whether Brahma Baba generally acted intuitively or logically. Whether he thought over issues rationally and scientifically or he did not apply his mind much but rather acted on the spur of the moment as guided by his inner voice. Again, was his approach to problems



and application of solutions at the micro and limited level or at macro level on a grand scale? Also, did Baba understand the difficulties of others and guided them in their problems under static conditions or under dynamic conditions?

In this connection, it should be understood that Baba's approach was a combination of all of these. Baba had a

very dynamic personality and he looked at things under dynamic conditions and yet he was static, rather firm, like a rock as far as basic principles of life are concerned.

Baba's Macro approach

Baba's approach was, in truth, macro. He called it 'behad' = unlimited. His mind thought of an action or project in all its three aspects of time and in terms of its effect upon all the mankind as a whole. He said, "We should think of the future results of an action and should keep in mind whether it would be beneficial if others also follow it." He called it the *Loka-Sangraha* aspect of an action and he wanted to see an action on a wider canvas of intellect. He wanted big things, big charts, big pictures and big or spacious spiritual centres, and schemes which have lasting effect and mass appeal.

His message also was for mankind as a whole and he talked of the spiritual welfare of all through the guidance of God, the Father of all mankind. He wanted the whole world to be (Contd. on page no. 33)

ver the centuries, people have been venerating and honouring Religious Founders in each religion from time to time. Rather, the followers of each religion feel highly honoured in celebrating the birthdays of their Religious Founders. The teachings of these Messengers have been found to be very useful as per the times and situation in the world. However the world drama scenario is such that it follows the law of 'increasing decay' starting with Golden Age through Silver, Copper and Iron Ages. We are now at a junction where people of all faiths, though finding some solace in their worship and recitation of their respective scriptures, appear to be grasping at the limited; seekers are on the search for tangible, spiritual Sometimes experiences. followers of the same faith divide themselves in different groups leading to differences of opinion and settlement of accounts with violent means. At

such a time, genuine seekers are looking for a way out to withdraw and detach from the noisy and violent atmosphere and connect with the Supreme Being, thereby upholding the highest tenets of religion (spiritual values). There are many groups all over the world who are pursuing these goals with their own respective practices or meditations, and yet the atmosphere all over the world paints a very grim picture for humanity even in terms of basic survival. Perhaps that's the reason why religions seem to have lost its core strength, resulting in a weakening of the application of values in peoples' lives.

About 80 years ago, one religious-minded devotee of Hindu faith, heard God's call of awakening: Dada Lekhraj experienced divine visions and became a visionary for reinstallation of values in the lives of individuals. Under God's direct command, a very different but revolutionary

spiritual educational institution came into being, in 1937, at Hyderabad-Sindh and Karachi. The new outfit was given the name, "Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya". The uniqueness of this new institution happened to be the Spiritual and Administrative system created as per guidance of the Supreme Being. When the institution began in Hyderabad-Sindh (now Pakistan), most of the beneficiaries who joined the institution (then known as Om Mandali) as regular devoteestudents were several families who brought along young children. Until then, women played a very conservative role of being just daughters, wives, and home-makers but with the advent of Om Mandali middleaged women and young girls started playing a unique leadership role in this newly formed spiritual institution. As part of their intense training, they did spend 14 long years in learning and practising the

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depths of Spirituality as enshrined in the Shrimad Bhagwad Gita and other scriptures. During long hours of meditation, they would chant 'Om', and this charismatic and soothing voice inspired the practitioners to experience peace of mind and happiness through elevated actions.

Depending on the level of spirituality and teaching, the role of leadership was bestowed onto Mateshwari Saraswati, Didi Manmohini, Dadi Prakash Maniji, and other senior Dadis. Most of the founding members, who became valuable spiritual teachers in different parts of India, have proceeded on their journey in the Advanced Party group. Presently our most respected Dadi Jankiji, Dadi Gulzarji and Dadi Ratan Mohiniji continue to carry Incorporeal Supreme Father, God Shiva's flag around the globe to awaken the conscience of human beings to become worthy children of God.

It's a very joyous occasion that we started off the New Year 2016 by celebrating the completion of 100 years of Rajyogini Dadi Jankiji, Chief of Brahma Kumaris. Dadiji was born in 1916, in the northern province of Sindh. Since her early days, the concern for wellbeing of others has been a



driving force in her life. She began her spiritual apprenticeship in 1937 at the age of 21 and was one of

the founding members.

After serving throughout India the years following in independence, she moved to London, UK, in 1974 and from there her vision and drive saw the organisation's teachings carried into more than 120 countries. Now internationally acknowledged as a great spiritual leader, Dadi's lifelong focus has been to align her mind and heart to God's will and purpose. She experiences God as a source of pure love and wisdom, and has made those qualities the foundation of her life. This spiritual strength enables her to be a beacon of light in the lives of others. Through the structured and disciplined method of spiritual development, she has shown thousands of people of all backgrounds and walks of life how to regain true self-respect, becoming free of addictive and negative tendencies and thereby able to contribute more to present-day society as well as a future world.

Dadiji has steered the

development of several international projects promoting values and action at the grassroot level. In 1992, Dadi was invited to be one of the ten Keepers of Wisdom, an eminent group of world spiritual leaders convened to advise the Earth Summit in Brazil on the fundamental spiritual dilemmas which underpin current worldwide environment issues.

In 1997, the Janki Foundation for Global Health Care was established and launched in her honour in London. A charitable trust, it supports the work of the Global Hospital and Research Centre in Mt Abu, Rajasthan, as well as promoting greater awareness of holistic health and the spiritual dimension of health care world-wide.

In 2004, she was awarded the Medal of Independence by The King of Jordan for humanitarian work. She is an international patron of Rights and Humanity, patron of the World Congress of Faiths and a member of the Global Peace Initiative of Women.

Dadi was invited as a major speaker at the Parliament of the World's Religions and addressed the closing plenary session together with the Dalai Lama and other representatives of the major faiths, Melbourne, Australia, December 2009.

In the build-up to her 100th year, Dadi Jankiji continues to travel extensively, enabling leaders from the realms of politics, religion, science, medicine, education and other fields to generate spiritual strength by renewing their link with the Supreme Soul.

Respected Dadi Jankiji deserves to be honoured and decorated with garlands of love and affection from all the sisters and brothers from across the globe.

One of the very prominent figures of this spiritual institution (Yagya) is Rajyogini Dadi Hirday Mohiniji, Additional Chief of Brahma Kumaris. At the age of eight, Dadi Gulzar was one of the original members of a boarding school set up in Sindh in 1937 by Brahma Baba. Within a few years, she was bestowed with the special gift of being a Trance-Medium, with the ability to travel to the Subtle Region with her subtle



consciousness, and receive Godly messages from time to time for the betterment of individuals and society. 

AN EXPERIENCE WITH BRAHMA BABA

am very fortunate that I along with my parents met Baba in January 1958 at Kanpur. At that time there was no formal centre in Kanpur. I was just eight and a half years old. Mamma and Baba used to come to Delhi, Kanpur, Mumbai and Punjab during winter as Mount Abu was very cold those days.

I do not exactly remember, but probably it was May 1959 (during our school summer vacations) when I first went with my parents to sweet Madhuban. From Kanpur nearly a group of 40 departed and we were a part of it. Baba and Mamma used to meet each one personally as well as in the group. On the very first day of our arrival, I met both my 'Aloukik' parents. Baba would ask some or other question to everyone, e.g. "Have you met Baba before?" Or He would ask the mothers, "How many children do you have?" (To give regular answers we were well trained by our teachers).

front of Baba. He gave me such sweet, powerful 'drishti' that tears started rolling down my eyes. Baba asked me why I was in tears. I did not know what to reply. Baba extended his arms and took me in his lap. I forgot the world, He asked me: "Have you met Baba before?" I said "No Baba, I am meeting you for the first time". Baba smiled. Then I discovered that my teacher was looking at me and I remembered what to say, I immediately corrected myself and said "Yes Baba, I met you 5000 years ago". Baba laughed and laughed, then patted my back and said, "Child has learnt the lesson well". As children, we did not understand 'Gyan' much but this sentence of Baba became a blessing for me. Reading Murli everyday became an important part of my daily routine. I am proud to record that since then, I have never missed even a single Murli.

During the same visit, we had an opportunity to have a special personal meeting with Baba in which he gave me directions for my life. We were sitting in front of Baba's room on a cot (Baba, my father, my mother and myself) and looking at me, Baba said to my father, "You must give this child good education and that too in English medium I will send her abroad".

Let me share, at that time, around 1959-60, there were no centres abroad but Baba visualized and he did send me on several tours abroad! Baba is 'Jani Jananhar' (Knows everything).

Every year, we used to visit Madhuban during summer vacations. It is as though I grew up in Madhuban only.

I have memorable incidents from my last meeting with Baba. We were seven Kumaris sitting in Baba's room, from Banglore visiting Madhuban. Manmohini Didi said to Baba that Asha gives lectures in English. Baba used to encourage Kumaris, so he asked me to speak in the evening class and said that he would also come to listen. I nodded and said "Ji Baba". The topic that he gave

me was World Peace. Baba's personality was so charismatic that one would forget everything sitting in front of him. When I came out of Baba's room, I realized what I had said to Baba. How could this happen? No, I am not going to speak, that too in front of Baba. Sister Rosy who was also our teacher said, 'there is no other way out, you will have to speak'. It was evening class in History Hall, I sat on the 'Gaddi' and hurriedly spoke on the subject decided. Inside I was feeling very happy and said to myself, "Thank God! Baba did not come". But Baba was very clever and great. He did not come inside but stood outside the hall and from the first window heard me speak.

After finishing, I came down the 'sandali' and Baba entered. Sister Nalini of Ghatkopar, Mumbai, and Sister Lata of Surat shared how Baba heard the whole speech. That evening Baba spoke the Murli on World Peace. Then he started calling me 'Englishwali'.

My last meeting with Baba was in 1968 after that I did not meet him in corporeal form. It was again summer vacation and I was in the second year of University. Sister Santosh of Meerut, Neera (my younger sister) and myself went to Baba's room to say 'Good Night' to him. Baba gave me very powerful, love-full 'drishti' and said "Child, always remember whatever I do, others will follow". At that time I did not realize why Baba said so. But after one year I had the realization. Since then I found Baba has put me in various roles where I have to constantly remember Baba's words which are like a 'Vardan' to me. To my surprise when I met him for the first time in Avyakt form in 1969 (Teachers training), he again said "You have to make others also like yourself". These words always ring in my ears and keep me attentive and alert.

Tormally when we join a group, and undertake a journey to meet a spiritually elevated person, our mind starts contemplating his physical appearance, based on the description we have read in the books or the impression formed by looking at his photograph, or even on the basis of experiences narrated by those who have met him before. This would be true when we talk of sages and saints.

I had the fortune of having my first meeting with Pitashri Brahma Baba, in the year 1958. I vividly recollect how my attention was immensely drawn to his inner radiant personality. In physical appearance, Baba looked extremely royal, but simple – he combined dignity with humility. He looked like an embodiment of spiritual knowledge and a perfect Raja Yogi. He emitted vibrations of love and affection, purity and peace, contentment and tranquillity.

Vibrations of Divinity

We had been told that Brahma Baba is the corporeal medium of The Supreme Soul-Incorporeal God Shiva and acts as His chariot and that we could meet God through Brahma's medium. I continued to gaze at Brahma Baba and his impressive and elegant personality and was really amazed to notice how the constant company of God Shiva had transformed him, both spiritually and physically, so much that merely by remaining in his presence, even an ordinary person could get the feelings and vibrations of divinity.

The very first lesson taught in this spiritual university is to feel and realize, 'I am a soul, child of the holiest Supreme Soul, God, and I should endeavour to become pure and holy like my Supreme Father.' My first meeting with Brahma Baba gave me the feeling and experience of having met the Supreme Soul—God Himself, for as I learnt later, God Father Shiva manifests His innumerable qualities and virtues through the medium of Brahma. and realization. At the same time, the realization also came that Brahma Baba is the Father of the humanity, the New Man, Adi Dev. Along with this came the inner thought that I should also follow in Brahma Baba's footsteps.

Constant Bestower and Donor:

I could also notice that in the company of God Shiva, Brahma Baba himself had become fulfilled, accomplished and a constant bestower, and donor. No formal words of blessings were spoken, yet it was my experience that I, the soul, was being bestowed and blessed with some subtle light and might. This experience of light and might was so strong that it developed

into a determined thought that I must become a worthy child of Shiv Baba and Brahma Baba. In a way, the process of inner transformation started taking place. The process of some natural change inside me was set in motion. Brahma Baba's looks started drawing up an illustration or a picture of a Perfect Being. I am not trying to narrate his description, but this is what was going on inside me. I might say that I saw him as an image of Perfection, and just a few moments of his presence began to create inside me the pure and positive desire and thoughts to become pure and elevated. He was indeed a living idol, who really created an ideal aim and objective in my entire life. Like this, I had many other experiences during my subsequent meetings with Brahma Baba. After the brief meeting, we had a chance to listen to his talk. He spoke simple words, but those words were full of wisdom and every word of his was a blessing and a boon. Every act, every movement of his body left a permanent impression on my mind, and set the path to be followed by us. Purity, wisdom and truth were being transmitted through each word that he spoke.

Free from influences

As we all know, Brahma Baba occupied a very elevated position in the material as well as spiritual world but his relationship with us, whom he affectionately called 'sweet and beloved children' was extremely sweet, loving and friendly. His company was so attractive and affable that I would go to Mount Abu and meet him very frequently. This continued for full 11 years. At the time of my first meeting in the year 1958, I was only 16 years old and he was 82. But at no time did I experience any barrier; there was no difference of age, no generation gap. His Company always made me feel free from all *loukik* (bodily, worldly) bondages. This is because he was himself free from the bondage of the vices of previous karmas, and all sorts of influences and impacts. You could talk to him freely like a friend, like a child, learn from him continuously and feel confident in his presence.

Persons of all age groups felt very comfortable and at ease with him, because he used to give company through his subtle personality. His foremost desire was to create powerful, active and accurate children – children who could help others to become like the father and also to render unlimited and untiring service to humanity. I have had many, many wonderful experiences in my life in the sweet attractive and elevated company of Brahma Baba – our sweet Baba.



came in Godly knowledge in 1955. I was then a final year student of B.Sc. Our family used to live in Ambala Cantt. In neighbourhood, a widow mother was living. Her parents' house was in Gurgaon where a B.K. Centre had been opened. She got an opportunity to go to the centre and even though she didn't understand the knowledge much, she developed great love for the sisters and invited them to her house.

Mother started going to BK Centre

On the invitation of that mother, two sisters went to her house in Ambala. One was Sis. Leela (who was doing Godly service in Secunderabad), the other was her associate Sis. Krishna. The mother, on whose invitation the sisters had come, didn't have much interaction with people but sisters used to insist her to do the service of bestowing Godly knowledge to the people. That mother told my mother that two goddesses had come who gave very good knowledge. Then I said to my mother, "Tell me what they speak about". Even though my mother couldn't understand much knowledge, but she was very much impressed by the sisters' divine love which she kept speaking about. One day the sisters said that they had a picture of Kalpa Tree which was published from Japan and they wanted to get it framed for Godly service. My mother brought it home for me to get it framed. I liked the picture very much because it had the photos of all the gods and goddesses. I went to the market and got the work done. The sisters were amazed to see the frame, and they asked my mother, "Who got it done?" When my mother told them about me, they expressed their desire to meet me. My mother would insist me daily to go to Geeta Bhawan and meet the sisters. I would think that since I was so educated, I would grill them and this would make them uncomfortable. Finally, one day my mother took me to the centre and introduced me to the sisters. At Geeta Bhawan, daily 500-600 people used to come to listen to the spiritual discourse. While roaming in the evening, my

friend and I went there and seated ourselves in the back. While listening to them, I liked one of the points they mentioned. They said, while performing a karma, the link should be connected with God; this is Karma Yoga. I'd read many books of different writers but this definition of Karma Yoga looked very easy, true and good. Then, I began to listen to the spiritual discourse daily. When the sisters came to know, they called me to meet them.

Impressed by the point of Drama

When I went to meet the sisters, Sister Leela told me the point of Drama that we had met earlier also in the same way and the same room was there. When I came to know that this Drama is eternal, then the receding admiration towards God thrived. Thereafter, I kept on listening to the sister for one and a half hour and all my questions dissolved. I felt deep vibrations of purity from the sisters. It was evident that what they were speaking was truth.

Brahma Kumari sisters stayed at our house

When the priest of Geeta Bhawan of Sanatan Dharma Mandal came to know about the discourses, he got very angry. That time my mother had gone to a pilgrimage on fulfilment of her wish. She was accompanied by the entire family. The priest used to have meals at our home. When my mother returned and noticed that because of behaviour of the priest, the group of BK students had ceased to come, she rebuked him asking him why he did that during their absence. The sisters said, "It's alright as we have given message to Baba that we'd go back home." But my mother insisted that the sisters should stay in our house till some other arrangement was made. That time, we used to live in a rented house as our own house was being built. We allowed the sisters to stay in the upper portion of the house where I used to study. It was during this time that Dadi Janki also came. Three sisters got themselves accommodated in one room. For two months, the sisters remained in our house and daily the spiritual classes were conducted. After some days, a house was found for the sisters. The rent at that time was just Rs. 32.

Experience of Loving & Affectionate Lap of Sweet Baba

In 1956, I went to Mount Abu along with BK Sisters to meet beloved most Baba. During those days Headquarters was at Kota House Mt. Abu. Since the time I got this Godly knowledge I was eager waiting to meet Baba face to face. At last the time came & we reached Mt. Abu to meet Baba at Kota House. The group was waiting in a Hall and finally, Brahma

Baba (the corporeal medium of God Shiva, whom we lovingly call Shiv Baba) came to meet all of us. It seemed as if a cool and sweet breeze touched me and passed through my being, the tiredness of life's journey disappeared and was replaced by new zeal. I felt for some time as if I'd forgotten everything and was watching my long lost Father (God Shiva). I just kept watching. I didn't know even where from I had come there and what I had to do? Or how I should welcome and meet Baba? In fact, I wasn't told by anyone how to welcome and meet Baba. I just kept watching Baba and I came closer and closer to Baba and then I went to the loving and affectionate lap of my sweet Baba and like a small child, experienced peace and happiness. I cannot express the joy, peace and unlimited love that I experienced from Baba at that time. It was just my Baba and myself! So, this was my first meeting in which I was left spell bound by his spiritual charisma.

God's order to join college

Before meeting Baba, I had a wish to become an engineer. In 1956, Thapar Institute of Engineering was opened in Patiala and I got selected in it. In the meantime, I also got Godly knowledge. Thus, when I got the letter of selection, I was not so happy because then my aim was to become like Sri Narayan and not an engineer. In my opinion,

there are many engineers; but are they happy? I wanted to dedicate my life for world service. I shared my wish with my mother that I didn't want to become an engineer but my father was adamant that I should join the institute.

When the sisters came to know about it, they wrote a letter to Baba, "Baba, here, a conflict is going on in an instrument family." On this, Baba replied, "Sweet child, Om Prakash, you're a very good instrument of Godly Service; it is Baba's advice that you should join the Engineering college. This will also help to do much service." I thought, since God has said this, I must follow His advice. There, I met Bro. Atam Prakash and we used to have discussion on spiritual knowledge.

In the college, everyone would get a separate room. My room was adjacent to the room of Bro. Atam Prakash. I used to meditate and read *murli* in my room. Bro. Atam used to come in my room. Sometimes, he would sing songs on 'Mother India'. I'd ask him which Mother India he was referring to; then he would reply that it was mother earth. Then, I'd tell him that mother earth is nonliving thing. Thus, a spiritual conversation started between us. Then, I shared the knowledge of soul with him. Initially, he debated with me for 3-4 days: but later he agreed that we're not bodies but souls. One day I needed a matchstick. I went to Bro. Atam's room for the first time. I said, "Bro. Atam, I need a matchstick; do you have it?" He opened a box and started searching it. As I sat on his chair, I looked in the room; it was written at many places, 'I'm a soul, not a body'. Thus, Bro. Atam also began to inculcate knowledge and listen to Murli.

Baba gave a letter and *Toli* (Sweet) to Bro. Atam Prakash

Thereafter, Baba's letter came from Madhuban that both Baba and Mamma were coming to Rajouri Garden, Delhi to celebrate Diwali with spiritual children. They were coming from Madhuban to Delhi for the first time. Bro. Atam Prakash came to me carrying a bag and said, "I'm going to Delhi to meet Baba and Mamma". I wrote a letter and gave it to him. After staying there for some days and meeting Baba-Mamma, Bro. Atam came to my house at Ambala Cantt. He gave me Baba's letter and a box of toli. Baba wrote in the letter. "Child, this child is coming; he'll give you all the news; this child is very qualified and promising and he'll do a lot of service." After reading the letter, it seemed to me that since Baba himself had given him the certificate, Atam Prakash must be a good brother. Thereafter, we both went to Patiala where we were supposed to open a centre. We left the

hostel and began to stay in the rented centre. Here, Dadi Janki ji also stayed with us and became instrumental for service at various places. We learnt a lot from Dadiji and under her guidance, the centre in Patiala was opened.

Respect for others' Feelings

Once, I had brought a party of some brothers and sisters of Jabalpur to meet Baba at Madhuban. In this party, an old mother had brought some rice and she had a hearty wish that these should be cooked in Madhuban. She shared her wish with me. I wondered what the little amount of rice would do. By the way, I went to Baba and apprised him of that mother's wish. Baba immediately called Bholi Dadi (Bholi who was in charge of Baba's kitchen in Madhuban) and said, "Whatever amount of milk you have got, don't curdle it; tomorrow kheer will be made from that milk. A mother has bought some rice; you make kheer from the same rice." Then, on the next day *kheer* was made from the same rice and it was served along with the meals to all the BK brothers and sisters in the class. On this, that mother's happiness knew no bounds. Baba was such a Benefactor of the Poor. To Baba what mattered was the feelings/ intentions of the child. He understood everyone's feelings and respected the same. \bullet

ADI DEV BRAHMA

Hinduism perceives the whole creation and its cosmic activity as the work of three fundamental forces symbolized by three deities, who constitute the Hindu Trinity or 'Trimurti': Brahma – the creator, Vishnu – the sustainer, and Shankar – the destroyer.

Brahma is considered to be the creator of the universe and of all beings and is regarded as the Father of Dharmas or religions. Dharma can be described as the observance of natural, universal laws which enables humans to be contented and happy, and saves them from degradation and suffering. Dharma is the moral law combined with spiritual discipline that guides one's life. Hindus consider dharma the very foundation of life. In the Hindu pantheon, Brahma is commonly represented as having four heads, four arms, sometimes having 100 arms and as per other scriptures having 1000 arms and red skin. Unlike other Hindu gods, Brahma carries no weapon in his hands. He holds a water-pot, a spoon, a book of prayers or the Vedas, a rosary and sometimes a lotus. He sits on a lotus in lotus pose and moves around on a white swan, a bird known for possessing the magical ability to separate milk from a mixture of water and milk. Brahma is often depicted as having long white beard, with each of his heads reciting the four Vedas.

The scriptures sing his praise: "Brahma vande Jagat-Guru" i.e. "Respect Brahma as Preceptor of the world.", because Brahma has taught the whole world the moral codes and ethics of life. Brahma is also called 'Indra' i.e. the conqueror of sensuality. These things represent Brahma as a learned man having sufficient knowledge of the world. As Brahma is shown with scriptures in his hand, some people say Brahma has saved Vedas, the main religious scriptures of Hinduism from demons. It is also said that whenever any problems were faced by deities, they would approach him to consult and to be saved from humiliations. The arms of Brahma represent the Brahmins of this Confluence

Age who cooperate whole heartedly with Prajapita Brahma for establishing the deity Sovereignty on the Godly advice of God Shiva.

Brahma is always depicted old, having a beard. This means Brahma is not a deity but an aged human being having knowledge and experience. The true spiritual knowledge of the world is delivered by God Himself through Brahma. A new world is established which is called Paradise or Heaven or Satyug where there is no trace of sorrows and sufferings. The five elements and the nature are pure. Procreation takes place not by sex-lust but by pure enormous willpower through meditation taught by God Himself. RAJYOGA FOR BLISS AND PEACE

piritual wisdom and spiritual evolution depend on achieving higher and higher and purer and purer consciousness. Siddhartha Gautama or Lord Buddha prescribed a technique for spiritual purification called as Vipassana. It elaborates that our original consciousness in pure, calm and deep like a serene lake. This is called as undifferentiated consciousness. Thoughts, emotions and desires act like stone thrown into water of the lake creating turbulence and waves. Restoring the original quality of the consciousness depends on identifying the nature of the waves which contribute to our Vrutti or Nature. This first step to emancipation is called as differentiated Perception. The root cause of sufferings is clinging to our habits, ego and insatiable longing. Dharma means laws of nature which govern the whole Universe. Today, in Iron Age the meaning of Dharma has deteriorated to divisions and sub-division of human race into multiple sects. Mind consists of four processes-Vinnana or undifferentiated

consciousness, Sana means Perception or differentiated consciousness, Vedana means the sensation that arises from perception and Sankhara means reaction to the sensation. 'I' means ego or instinctive assertion of our identity. The technique of Vipassana challenges this unreal identity and brings about self-purification. Met-Bhavana or Shubh Bhavana becomes an essential component in Vipassana.

Russian R & D institutes identify the existence of benevolent, healing energy that functions on **love** and pervades through whole of the Universe. Dr. Deepak Chopra calls this Universal consciousness as **Macrocosm**. Lord Buddha calls the innumerable indivisible subatomic particles of the Universe as **Kala pas.** Dr. Deepak Chopra calls this subconscious unit called as mind as **Microcosm**.

All such terminologies have given rise to a massive confusion in human consciousness. I have experienced a stint of nearly four years in ISKON, a global organization with millions of

followers. Gaur Gaurang **Prabhu**, an international speaker for ISKON, used to come to Sir J J Hospital to deliver the divine knowledge about Krishna Consciousness. His charisma attracted several ardent followers in medical students as well as teaching staff. Mesmerizing lectures on divinity in easy and understandable fashion, chanting and prayers used to bring great solace to me who was passing through a very difficult and stressful time in life. Undisturbed mental peace was the sole desire at that point of time. Perhaps I had completed my pre-ordained and precise role in Bhakti yog. So there was arranged an event for my further spiritual progress. I prostrated in front of the wonderfully decorated deity. A celestial voice told me "Hare Krishna", your feet are pointing towards the statue of Prabhu La Pada. I changed my position. Once again the celestial voice gave the word of caution. In desperation I asked: Scriptures tell us that God is omnipresent. So even the floor on which we walk must be having God. Is this not a sin? ach soul has its own body, its own part. Each soul s different and has a different role in this World Drama. STONE THAT BUILDERS REJECTED HAS BECOME THE CORNER STONE!

Ive years back what happened in my city prepared my mind to embrace the BK teachings. A young girl was on her way back from her work. A thief snatched her gold chain and ran away. She too ran after him and caught him, twisted his arms from behind, recovered her valuables. A Traffic Police vehicle that was passing by intervened and took the culprit into custody. Later it was found that the thief was actually a policeman who was also on his way back after duty; and robbery was his hobby. When the report appeared in the newspapers the next day, the Chief Minister of the State and high ups in the Police Department decided to directly appoint this exceptionally courageous and welleducated girl, if she would be willing, as an Inspector of Police. She was quite happy and the readers too were very happy to know this wonderful outcome.

It was around that time that I happened to watch Sister Shivani's TV series called Awakening with Brahmakumaris. I liked the way she explained how we can take charge of our destiny. In one of the episodes, she spoke about the origin of Brahma Kumaris organization and explained how Dada Lekhraj was directly chosen by God Shiva to serve as His instrument in establishing the Golden Age, which is to follow the present Iron Age. When she explained that although Dada Lekhraj was materially very rich, he was passionately searching for God and for answers to vital

questions on meaning of life, I could draw an easy parallel with the above-mentioned girl. She proved to be a real police-woman by her action which attracted direct appointment by the Government. Similarly, at a time when most of the religious leaders were becoming materially rich, here was a materially rich man, Dada Lekhraj, who was turning highly spiritual, unwittingly fulfilling God's elevated standards! Thus, it was natural for God Shiva to appoint Dada Lekhraj as His instrument for Golden Age. "Right now we are committed to probably more than three feet [one meter] of sea level rise... there is no reason to expect that ice sheets will melt at the same pace as they did in the past. According to the laws of physics, they will deteriorate faster. And they already are." SOUL-THE REALITY' – SCIENTIFIC PROOFS

n life questions like 'Who I am', 'What is the objective Lof my life' puzzle us many a time and we don't get the true answer and thus the puzzle remains unsolved. The very basic reason is that we are too engrossed in the materialistic world and tuned merely to bodyconsciousness. We identify ourselves with physical body only, but the fact is that we are more than the physical body. In Shrimat Bhagwat Gita it is clearly written: "The soul is the eternal being (immortal) and changes the body like we change the clothes". Since we are in bodyconsciousness even this deep knowledge about soul is wrongly interpreted and we say "every 'body' has a soul in it which takes rebirths". The slight shift in belief system from body-conscious to soulconscious stage makes all the difference in our attitudes and karma. At the time of death, soul departs and takes a new costume through which it expresses the recorded impressions/information and creates new ones as per the

karma in the present body and the process is repeated. The knowledge of "soul-the true self" is helpful not only in solving unresolved issues/pains/miseries in our lives, but it also makes the life more meaningful and worth enjoying. There are number of scientific evidence indicating its existence based on its appearance through specialized instruments, by studying near experiences death or reincarnation cases, which affirms that there is some driving force which keeps the human being alive.

Form of soul

Soul is a subtle energy like a tiny star situated in the centre of forehead and without it; physical body is unable to perform any activity, and we term it a dead body. It is composed of three faculties – thought, intellect and *sanskars* (impressions of thoughts and actions). Can it be seen by naked eyes or perceived through other senses? As it is metaphysical and not a physical thing, it is logical to comprehend that it cannot be seen through sense organs and not even with the powerful microscope because it is a subtle energy requiring the intellect or divine insight.

Scientific investigations have shown that different living beings have different types of latent energy-spheres around them to their own characteristic emission. This emission called aura is the layer of energy which interconnects all other subtle bodies and also acts like a shield covering and protecting our more refined subtle bodies like the mental, emotional, spiritual and astral bodies. There are two types of auras - physical aura, constituted by bio-plasma and bio-flux and the psychic aura, which is a circular domain of subtle waves of praña. Dr. Barbara Brennan who is an atmospheric physicist, psychotherapist and research scientist for NASA has devoted more than 20 years to a study using her unique skill and has proven the existence of a multilevel human energy field — the aura. She states "the HEF (Human Energy Field) is a luminous body surrounding and interpenetrating the physical body, which emits its own characteristic radiation and is usually called the 'aura'. Theoretical models proposed based on these observations suggest that aura can be divided into seven layers called 'bodies',

which surround and interpenetrate each other in successive layers. Each succeeding body is of finer particles having higher vibrations than the body it surrounds. Barbara describes "all the seven layers sparkle like strings of many tiny, rapidly blinking lights, each blinking at a different rate. Thus all of us have seven bodies which occupy the same space at the same time, each one extending out beyond the last, something we are not used to in daily life".

High voltage photographic techniques such as-electrophysiographic, corona discharge photography, and Kirlian photography are some of the proven techniques to measure the type and intensity of an aura. Significant alterations in the colours of the auras are formed in the state of shock, fear, mental disorder or psychological aberrations or those formed around diseased or weak parts of the body. These observations also helped formulating methods for the diagnosis or prediction of certain illnesses caused by biochemical or psychosomatic disorders. Dr. Thelma Moss of UCLA has observed and successfully recorded the eminent coronas around the fingertips of some yogis and

spiritually elevated persons.

Kirlian photography which is based on Kirlian effect-was first discovered by Russian scientist Semion Kirlian. It is a diagnostic technique that uses high-voltage, high-frequency electrical field and the electrical field interacts with an object (for example, a part of the human body) and is photographed as coloured image, which is believed to reflect a person's aura. This technique is presently being used by doctors or health professionals in accurately assessing the various psychosomatic or depression like diseases and also in seeing the effect of treatments. The colour of the aura is greyish or darker in diseased conditions. So a person who is healthy at all these levels, has a bigger and brighter aura and vice versa in the case of an unhealthy person. Living beings can change their aura field dramatically and quickly. This provides scientists with unique tools to study physics of LIFE and consciousness using bioelectrography. Prof. Bunzen in Russia found that the response in Kirlian Aura seems to proceed (appear as soon or earlier than) electric processes in the brain during a decision making process. Spiritually we can say that aura is our very

own soul nature; it reflects our innermost thoughts, desires and feelings, emotions etc.

Dr. Donna and Feinstein are renowned personalities in this field who had shown the seven energy fields of the Human Aura explaining how the ethereal body exists prior to the physical body shapes it. These evidences provide the science behind aura which is used for curing psychosomatic many problems. Donna Eden has given definition along with detailed explanation of different layers/chakras and drawings of aura on her website named Eden Energy Medicine. The images of energy bodies as shown in 'Handout Bank' of the Energy Medicine institute (www.handoutbank.org) provide evidence for its existence.

All of the seven nested aura fields have different functions to perform, and concentric *chakra* band indicates that each one intersects with aura field. Ethereal Field is fluid and being closer to physical body can interact with physical body. It extends up to 5 inches from body which can be detected by infrared camera. Second layer forms protective sheath around the Ethereal Field. Third field

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(Mental/Emotional Field) seen as two fields emotional and mental body which is surrounded by Morph Field or 'ethereal template' or 'habit field', this layer of the aura holds the templates for all the fields within it. These templates are ideal forms which may or may not manifest in the inner layers. Physical as well mental or emotional illness affects this field. Fifth layer (The Celestial Field) is associated with higher spiritual forces, usually ascribed to the 6th and 7th chakras. The Celestial Field serves like an antenna to connect person with the Wisdom, Love, and Bliss of the Cosmos. Above scientific information can clearly be conceived by understanding of Godly Knowledge. Our most beloved 'God Shiva, i.e. Shiv Baba - The Knowledge-full' has given us the clear vision in a very simple way about 'the soul'. The vibrations require no medium and can be sent to far off places, which is basis of power through mind. These findings also confirm that "we are what we think" and depending upon our thought pattern we perform the acts which will design our destiny or so to say ultimately the state of universe.

New concept of 'Biocentrism' proposed by Dr. Robert Lanza corroborates to the theories given by many spiritual masters. Dr. Lanza is pioneer in stem cell research and was selected for TIME magazine year 2014 amongst hundred most prestigious personalities in the world. According to this new theory of Biocentrism, the universe cannot exist without life and consciousness. The theory challenges the old physiochemical paradigm, and poke into deeper questions regarding existence of soul, and what are the truths and functions related with soul. This changes the concept about life and proves that it is not merely the activity of an admixture of carbon, nitrogen and a few other elements; it suggests the exalted possibility that life is fundamentally immortal. Dr. Lanza postulates "it is life that creates the universe instead of the other way around. He asserts that current theories of the physical world do not work, and can never be made to work, unless you include consciousness (the observer) in the equation. He admits that his theory doesn't provide all the answers but should serve as foundation stone for future research to explain the inner workings of the universe. The 'Supreme Soul' has revealed all the truths about soul i.e., its form, abode, nature, and its journey in simple but logically convincing way.

Near death experiences

An article (dated: 29th Aug 2014, by Barbara Johnson) titled 'German scientists prove life after death' is about the news regarding medical advancement to prove the existence of soul. A team of psychologists and medical doctors led by Dr. Berthold Ackermann conducted medically supervised clinical trials on 944 volunteers belonging to different religious faiths, Christian, Muslims, Jews, Hindus and atheists to study near death experiences. During the process, mixture of drugs including epinephrine and dimethyl tryptamine, were given to the volunteers, which allowed the body to survive the clinical death and the reanimation process without damage. Mixture of other drugs was used to put the body of the subject into coma temporarily, followed by reanimation process 18 minutes later. They have described that such a long duration of the experience was possible only by use of a new cardiopulmonary recitation (CPR) machine called the Auto Pulse. The scientists concluded from the study that all of the subjects had some memories of

their period of clinical death and majority of them described similar type of sensations. Dr. Ackermann and his team, consider the observations as evidence for the existence of the afterlife and of a form of dualism between mind and body.

"Most common memories include a feeling of detachment from the body, feelings of levitation, total serenity, security, warmth, the experience of absolute dissolution, and the presence of an overwhelming light" this is the conclusion which was drawn from the study.

Reincarnation of Soul

Evidence based on scientific studies has given a new meaning to the theory of reincarnation and now it is being proved that "we are eternal conscious energy which changes its physical costume (the body) birth after birth or describes the theory of reincarnation of soul". Many programs have been telecast on life regression to further affirm this. Institute for the Integration of Science, **Intuition and spirit** (IISIS website 415.244.9658), which is a non profit international organization, is involved in research on reincarnation with the objective to have peaceful

and enlightened world. It conducts conferences from time to time in which evidential data/ observations from case studies are presented. The observation that souls take rebirth during which it can change religion, race, ethnic affiliation and gender from lifetime to lifetime has societal great implications. The knowledge can help us see ourselves in a broader way leading to universal brotherhood and thus create a more peaceful world. These points have been cleared by the 'Supreme Teacher' who has given us knowledge about us (that we human beings are the souls having physical bodies (costume) to perform its role) and about Himself (He is also a soul, though supreme in its virtues, HE is Father of all the souls, so called Parampita Param Atma, the self explanatory name or appropriate adjective to be used for Him.)

There are number of books on such type of studies. Dr. Adrian Finkelstein, one of the early pioneers in the field of past-life therapy and healing, authored a book 'Your Past Lives and Healing Process' published in 1985 and another book entitled 'Marilyn Monroe Returns: the healing of a soul' published in 2006. Dr. Walter

Semkiw authored a book 'Return of Revolutionaries: the case for reincarnation and soul groups reunited' in 2003 and 'Born Again: reincarnation cases involving international celebrities' published in 2006. 'Life before life' is another book written by Jim Tucker, who clearly demonstrates the fact that the religion changes as the soul takes new birth, thus proving the theory of soul and its rebirth as human being. 'Many Lives Many Masters' is another book written by Dr. Brian Weiss famous psychiatrist who practises in Miami, Florida. The book deals with the true story of his young patient. Dr Weiss tried hypnosis to cure her emotional problems in her present life. In the series of hypnosis sittings (under trance stage), she recalled not only past incidents related to her phobia but also recalled many "past life" memories which were the cause of her problems in the present life. 'Same Soul, Many Bodies' is a book by Dr Brian Weiss published in 2004. It reveals the truth that our future lives can be transformed by knowing the facts about true self - the soul which is eternal and it changes its physical body birth by birth. 'Miracles Happened' by the same author also confirms that (Contd. on page no. 34)

transformed and the things to be done on a grand and magnanimous scale.

He also looked at things in their entirety. He did not believe in water-tight compartments. He did not divide issues into political, religious, economic, social aspects etc. but talked of solutions that affected all aspects of life and at all levels of existence. His conception of Swaraj (Self-rule) for example, had political, economic, cultural, social, moral and biological content; it had undivided political economic sovereignty, affluence, cultural and social sublimation and unity and moral excellence and was characterized by physical and mental health. His thought was that life is one and should be considered as such and not divided into pigeon holes.

The Kalpa Tree and the World Wheel – the two illustrations that he devised for illustrating the World History, give a macro view of the world or of time and society. And, moreover, in each one of these illustrations is history, religion, philosophy, metaphysics and ethics, all combined in one. These give a comprehensive world view, a cosmic vision, a broad perspective, an all-inclusive and holistic study. The very title of these illustrations says that these depict religio-political history and geography of the world, i.e., in which religion, politics, science, history, geography and sociology all are one and at one place.

Similarly, Brahma Baba talked of liberation of all souls. Even when few people were listening to his teachings in his chamber, he said that he thought as though he was addressing the whole mankind or at least Brahma Kumars and Brahma Kumaris of all centres. He said that though there are individual differences, yet human nature, all over the world, is the same. He therefore prophesized that one day, these teachings will be adopted by people of all races and religions and looked on his discourses from that angle. He considered himself as the Father of the whole human race and not as a mere founder of an institution.

Baba also had a micro approach

And yet Baba had a micro approach as well. He paid heed to individual difficulties and individual *sanskaras*. He said that all are not identical and each one had also to be dealt with at their individual level of understanding and keeping in view their individual background. Though mankind is one whole, yet each individual is separate and each one therefore requires personal attention and individual guidance. He therefore, did not neglect the micro aspect of things. As he wanted big things, he also favoured small and concise articles, brief talks and essence of knowledge. He wanted things to be tried on a small scale first and then to be applied on a mass scale or produced on a grand scale.

He thus took keen interest in the welfare of every individual. He gave individual guidance and spent some time with individuals and had personal relations with everyone at an individual level. He believed in raising the moral level of individuals and, through them building up a new man and a new society. It was the result of his individual attention and interest that those who came into contact with him became dedicated to the cause he enunciated and became his loyal and devoted children.

Baba worked as God's medium and also acted intuitively

Baba's work at micro or macro level was based not only on his intuitive planning or on his inner voice but also on deep understanding and spiritual

insights. Baba asked each one to apply their mind properly and well to the task allotted to them. He wanted each one to use their power of judgment and discretion and he appreciated intelligent and well-planned functioning. But, in his personal case, it was Shiv Baba also, who worked through him, adopting him as His medium. So, while he thought of solutions intuitively and acted on inner voice and also applied his mind, Shiv Baba also spoke through him and expressed His will through him.

Dynamic personality, firm on universal principles

Moreover, Baba had a dynamic outlook. He was willing to concede some concession and lighten the rigours of spiritual discipline in individual cases, if the situations demanded them, but at the same time, he was static as far as fundamental, universal and principles basic were concerned. It is, however, a major characteristic of his that he acted on Shrimat, i.e., as God Shiva's obiter dicta, covenants or edicts demanded. His voice was in fact, his Master's voice. Whether he acted on a micro or macro level, dynamically or statically, he acted on God's advice and his voice had a moral and spiritual basis and had the motive of the good of all.

In Sind, when some leaders of the Anti Om Mandali asked him to give up his teachings of the principle of celibacy, his response was static. He did not budge from his principle of celibacy, which in fact, was based on God Shiva's dictum of total purity. He refused to persuade young girls to marry, saying that it was their personal decision and that his teachings of celibacy were for all though, each one was free to adopt it or reject it. But if someone was working in the military and had no arrangements for separate cooking, he took into consideration his individual difficulty and advised him to persuade his cook not to put onions or garlic in his vegetable dish and yet he permitted him to accept vegetarian meals from the common or community kitchen for the time being, whereas his original instruction for all was to eat food prepared in yogic state. In short, it may be said that Baba's approach was, in the main, spiritual and for the wellbeing of each one individually and for the world at large and in suggesting solutions, he acted on Shiv Baba's advice, which came to him spontaneously and fused with his intuition and appealed to his reason.
