Remain in Baba's attention

Peace is our natural nature. Purity, truth, patience, humility and sweetness - these are natural too, within us all. Make sure not one is missing, day or night. Whoever it is, these are the qualities God Himself has given as an inheritance. There is great intoxication of this inheritance that God gives. The wonder is that the Teacher is also the Satguru and Friend. We say: 'Ji Ha' ('Yes'). Baba has explained the whole cycle - how we go around and what we do in the Golden, Silver, Copper and Iron Age. Now do as much as you can. I have so much happiness, intoxication and faith in all these things that Baba has taught us. Think about what He is and has and what He gives us as an inheritance. What would I say to Baba? Baba it is Your wonder! With Baba's signals we stay peaceful and in silence. Baba has given us this ability to be quiet and peaceful. Sitting quietly is natural for us; the whole atmosphere becomes peaceful and wonderful.

Take the benefit of the present moment, being here in this atmosphere. We are on this journey of life and the more who are with us, the better. Have an attitude of renunciation, be an embodiment of intense tapasya and do service - virtues then become natural in our lives. Dadi likes it when we are obedient, faithful and honest. We feel someone is very good when they are obedient. These three increase Baba's glory and beauty. The pain and sorrow of others can be ended with vibrations of yoga. Baba touches the intellect and we catch this. Thank you Baba. Dadi has never said 'No' to any type of service. Baba says 'Have patience, oh mind'. Let there be this virtue, so the mind can be quiet. Not a dry quiet, but quietness in which there is happiness.

Do you have the experience that Dadi comes in your dreams? (*Many did*). This happens where there is love and honesty. When we need help and we are loving there is 'prem', a spiritual love, which is natural. Why? Because we are the mouth born children of Brahma. We are not warriors. Whenever help is needed we say, 'Yes.' Our love is unbreakable and unshakeable. We are tireless and have unbreakable faith and so are ever-ready. Baba loves such ones and they remain in Baba's attention. His attention is on us.

Yesterday Dadi thought she was about to leave the body and yet today she is better. How? By saying 'Yes, my Lord' and so Baba uses me for world service. My clothes are white and my pockets are empty. Whatever comes is for the Yagya. Dadi is told the sums that come to the Yagya and Dadi says 'Good'. Dadi doesn't write cheques or receive anything in her name, so there's no give or take in that way. Look at the royalty of Brahmin souls - Baba, Mama, Didi Manmohini and Dadi ji. Those who saw these souls saw that whatever came to the Yagya went to the Yagya. When there is honesty, love and truth, we always remain in the unlimited with Baba. We don't make plans for ourselves. Baba makes the plan and we say 'Yes, Baba, this has to be done.'

Have the dharna that only Baba is my true support. Baba has given me such an intellect that I know to see the Drama in a detached way. Apply a bindi, a full stop. Keep One Baba and then add the zeros. Then we can go beyond and our boat goes across. Whatever is in the Drama, play a special part. Whatever we do now will have an impact on the whole cycle and all of my 84 births - from the beginning to this final birth. In order to come at the beginning of the Golden Age, be like Lakshmi and Narayan. Churn the Ocean of Knowledge and sit alert. Remember Baba is the Truthful, the Blissful and the Living Being. Be constantly happy, not just sometimes. Who will come into the rosary of 8 jewels? Don't have the nature of doubting the self. Others may not have faith and trust in you but Dadi wants to instil this, so we all feel we can do it.

Dadi has seen how waste thoughts are very detrimental and bring great loss. Sometimes it isn't necessary to think or say anything. When Dadi was on the path of bhakti, if someone spoke at the time of prayer, I would show them a stern eye. A sensible person will take in useful and important things and keep them in their heart. When we came to Abu, Baba called me and said: 'Have you been to the Dilwala Temple? Go there and see your little alcove.' So in my thoughts during the day I go to the Dilwala Temple. Dadi thinks: Will I come into the rosary of 8 or not? She thinks she will... Do you have this feeling? This time is so valuable. Even if someone comes from afar and late, still they can go far when they have courage. As is the company, so we are coloured. As is the water and so are our words. Day and night let our activity reflect our teachings. Dadi asked the sisters: What was Dadi's face like when she was resting? They said it was good. Don't be alarmed but time is short. We must finish whatever weakness or defect we have and practise the power of realisation, so that we can implement real things. We can do this by keeping the intellect clear. It is a matter of vibrations - not words or language. Wherever we place our feet, let others feel that we belong to them.
